WHAT "EXACTLY" DID WE DO.....

- WA, OR, ID, & MT reached a consensus that while Sea Planes can be a vector, actual risk is probably pretty low due to;
 - Not the usual "User type"
 - Highly Professional group.....Licenses, ratings, ect.
 - Usually have quite a bit of \$\$\$'s tied up into their planes.....so they take care of them!
 - Proactive They approached us!
 (How many of our other user groups can say that?)
- We created an informal committee to get a PNW process together
 - Tom Woolf, Kate Wilson, Rick Boatner, Nicholas Zurfluh, Bruce Hinds, & me ©

ALSO

- We said "Let's be realistic"
- Sea Planes are <u>NOT</u> going to "fly" into our Watercraft Inspection Stations!
- How many of our States have the time, money, and personnel to go and inspect them???
- How many of our States actually have the authority?

If a Sea Plane lands in a lake and nobody is around...... did it actually land??

- We worked with <u>Bruce Hinds**</u>
 & the WA Sea Plane Pilots Association.
- And came up with an agreed upon process (for now ©)



SO.....

ANNUAL QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1: Watch the training video
 - 2: Take the test (only accessible after the video)
 - 3: Print your certificate carry it with you or keep it on display in your aircraft.
- 4: Keep a log of waters visited within the last 30 days and include a record of cleaning and/or decontamination.
- 5: Check State Requirements Page to see if permits, stickers or registration may be required.
