
Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Program

GOALS:


- To protect Oregon's water bodies against the introduction and spread of aquatic invasive species. Key element of the Oregon Conservation Strategy
- Educate everyone about aquatic invasive species.




2016 Summary of Watercraft Inspections and All Decontaminations

2017 Legislative Session

▶ HB 2321

- Removal of drain plug
- AIS permit required for 8 ft. or longer
- Specific Directs for Law Enforcement
- Allows OSMB to combine permits.
